We will evaluate your article and give you feedback if the article meets our standards and vision for the Nordic Osteopathic Journal.

Content

The goal is to submit two articles from each country to the journal. Please contact the editor if there are any problems submitting the number of articles.

The length of the longer articles should be between 500-1500 words. The shorter articles or comments should not be shorter than 250 words.

The reference style is set to "Numeric".

Submission of content

Please submit your content for the Nordic edition in a separate e-mail from the national content. All the content should be included in these e-mails. This includes photos and if there is any information that needs to be considered.

The Nordic and the national content should both be submitted by deadline.

Please add the photos directly into the articles where it should be, so that there won't be any misinterpretations.

Read-throughs and comments

Make sure that the articles and content have already been checked for spelling mistakes and other corrections before sending it.

If there are any comments in the article that needs to be taken into account, **please mark this in red** directly in the file. If there are any general comments, that needs to be considered, please make sure to inform this in the e-mail.
